

## Invitation

### 2<sup>nd</sup> International WTTV Veteran-Cup

from 9<sup>th</sup> of August to 11<sup>th</sup> of August 2019 in Senden-Ottmarsbocholt (Germany)

The tournament will take place:

Sports Hall, Clemens-Hagemann-Street 25, D-48308 Ottmarsbocholt (Westphalia/Germany)

#### Eligibility

All players with valid eligibility in any club of the German Table Tennis Federation (DTTB) and all players from foreign states are allowed to participate if they are older than 40 years or become 40 years old in the year of the event (born 1979 or earlier).

#### Age Groups (Leagues)

Seniors 40 (born 1979 – 1970), Seniors 50 (born 1969 – 1960), Seniors 60 (born 1959 – 1955)

Seniors 65 (born 1954 – 1950), Seniors 70 (born 1949 – 1945),

Seniors 75 (born 1944 – 1940), Seniors 80 (born 1939 or 1935), Seniors 85 (born before 1935)

Each player has to start in his own age group, excluding team and double matches, if the players are not members of the same age group; in this case they must play in the age group of the younger (youngest) player. At less than 6 participants the age group will be combined with the next younger age group.

#### Competitions

All competitions will be held in each category:

team (one woman und two men) - woman singles and men singles

woman doubles and men doubles - mixed double

#### Entry fee

singles 10 € - doubles and mixed doubles (each) 4 €

team (each team member) 8 €

#### Game system

It is played by the rules of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF). In each class the game mode is „best of five“ (3 sets to win) held as follows:

Singles will be played in groups of three or four players (round robin). The first and second place winner will be qualified for the main round.

In team competition (three games to win the match), the winners continue to play in the main round, teams eliminated in the first round are to continue in a consolation round.

## Players' exchange

Upon receipt of the messages we are trying to publish on the website [www.bwo-sport.de](http://www.bwo-sport.de) a forum for those players still looking for a male/female/team partner.

## Players commitment

Each player must play his match to the specified time and on the specified table according to the schedule. Each player is personal responsible for the information when and where to play. A player, who does not appear at the appropriate time/table, will automatically lose the game after a waiting period of 5 minutes. All players have to sign the result sheet at the end of the game and before leaving the table. Each player is entitled to a 5-minute break between two games.

## Protests

Protests will be heard by a three-member arbitration tribunal, the protest must be filed in writing immediately after the end of the game. Protests against a decision of the umpire are not allowed.

## Prizes

Prizes will be decided in accordance with the organizer. The first three of the main rounds will be awarded with medals or cups. The first two of the consolation rounds will be awarded with official documents.
